During the Summer term in SK we had fun with each of the six areas of learning:

Area of learning	
<p>Citizenship</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand what makes a good listener and why it makes you a good friend • Share and care – put yourself in their place. Stop and think before you act • Being happy and confident
<p>Language and Literacy</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Retell and demonstrate an understanding of the order and elements of stories (intro, characters, build up, problem, resolution) • Read and spell initial, middle and final sounds in common C.V.C. and some C.V.V.C. words • Use phonics with confidence to aid reading and independent writing (to include digraphs ch, sh, th, er, ar) • Understanding and demonstrate knowledge of sentence structure by writing stories and recounts • Understand where and how capital letters and full stops are used.
<p>Mathematical development</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Count, order and find one more or one less than a number from 0-20. • Use vocabulary involved in addition and subtraction • Use and understand vocabulary: more, less, bigger, smaller, heavier and lighter • Describe position • Use tables, and charts to record data • Confidently use vocabulary for 2D and 3D shapes

Knowledge and understanding of the world

- Habitats of the world – making observations about different environments and offering explanations
- Plants – life cycles

- Use Word with minimal support and understand that font and colour can be changed
